

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF THE ESPLANADE (SOUTHBOUND), WEYMOUTH FOR ANZAC PARADE 2019

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to prohibit the use of The Esplanade, Weymouth in a southbound direction only - between Lennox Street and Astrid Way, by cyclists, horse riders and all mechanically propelled vehicles, except those taking part in the event and emergency vehicles.

On Thursday 25 April 2019 between 10:40 and 11:30.

General traffic will be able to continue to use The Esplanade in a northbound direction.

The alternative route for diverted traffic will be via Lennox Street, Victoria Street and Astrid Way.

Traffic management officers will be stationed at either end of the closure to facilitate local public buses on service through the closure and maintain access to Brunswick Terrace.
