QUAYSIDE MUSIC FESTIVAL****SATURDAY 27<sup>th</sup> – SUNDAY 28<sup>th</sup> MAY 2017: Ref. 17/W005****TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH ROAD WAITING OR LOADING AND UNLOADING****Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> – Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> May 2017 – Quayside Music Festival**

On the above dates Custom House Quay (from St Mary Street to Town Bridge) will be closed to vehicular traffic between 8.00am and 11.00pm.

Pedestrian access to the area between the 'Rendezvous' and St Mary Street will be restricted. Pedestrians will be permitted to use Town Bridge Steps upwards from Custom House Quay to Town Bridge only.

The alternative routes for through traffic will be from the west via Commercial Road, Lower St Alban Street and St Thomas Street to St Edmund Street and from the east via St Mary Street, St Edmund Street and Lower St Edmund Street to Commercial Road.

The diversion route from the west through Lower St Alban Street and St Thomas Street will mean that the Prohibition of Driving Order in Lower St Alban Street which starts at its junction with St Nicholas Street will be revoked temporarily between these hours. In addition, parking spaces will not be available on Custom House Quay outside the 'Rendezvous'.
