

## **TERMINATION OF BERTHING LICENCE**

The owner(s) has the right to terminate the Licence. A Termination of Berthing Licence Form must be completed to record the owner(s) decision and returned to the Harbour Office. **Upon receipt** of the Termination Licence form, a 28 days' notice (14 days' notice if a temporary berth) period commences. The owner(s) remains liable for harbour dues and charges until such notice is completed or the vessel has been removed from the Harbour if later.
