Notice to Mariners No. 07/18 (T) UPDATE**

**QINETIQ RANGE CABLE RE-ROUTING (~~27th – 29th NOVEMBER 2018~~) 5th – 7th
DECEMBER**

1. Due to bad weather the works covered by this Notice to Mariners have been delayed by a week.
2. Mariners are advised that a new cable will be laid from the Degaussing Range at Newton's Cove (yellow buoys 2.5 cables SE of Stone Pier Light), around the end of the Stone Pier and across Weymouth Harbour entrance to No.1 Berth from 5th to 7th December.
3. Diving operations will be taking place in support of the activity. The dive vessel Scimitar will be displaying Flag Alpha when diving operations are taking place.
4. All harbour users are requested to take particular care when transiting the harbour, keeping speed to a minimum to avoid any wash and proceed with caution.
5. Any updates will be given on VHF Channel 12, which should be monitored by all vessels operating in or transiting the harbour.
6. Cancel this Notice to Mariners on Monday 10th December 2018 assuming all operations are complete. Timings are subject to weather conditions.

NB. Owners, Agents, Charterers, Marinas, Yacht Clubs and Recreational Sailing Organisations should ensure that the contents of this Notice are made known to the Masters or persons in charge of their vessels or craft.
