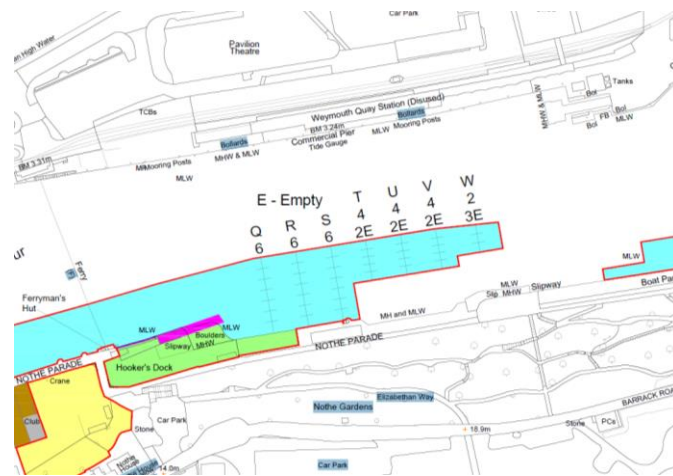

WEYMOUTH HARBOUR Notice to Mariners No. 03/19 (T)

WEYMOUTH SAILING CLUB MOORINGS

1. Mariners and harbour users are advised that extra permanent moorings will be laid in the vicinity of Weymouth Sailing Club from 1st February 2019 onwards. The moorings will be within the light blue area on the chart shown below. The new moorings are on the main channel side of rows Q to W. When the vessel is not on the mooring there will be a small line pick-up buoy in the position as has been the normal practice for other WSC moorings. The NE corner will be marked with a larger buoy.



2. Diving operations will be taking place in support of the laying activity. The dive vessel will be displaying Flag Alpha when diving operations are taking place.

3. All harbour users are requested to take particular care when transiting the harbour, keeping speed to a minimum to avoid any wash and proceed with caution.

4. Any updates will be given on VHF Channel 12, which should be monitored by all vessels operating in or transiting the harbour.

5. Cancel this Notice to Mariners on Friday 15th April 2019 when it will be assumed that the moorings are the standard configuration going forward.

NB. Owners, Agents, Charterers, Marinas, Yacht Clubs and Recreational Sailing Organisations should ensure that the contents of this Notice are made known to the Masters or persons in charge of their vessels or craft.
