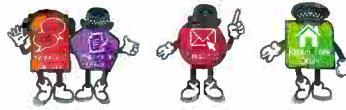


# Contacting Dorset Police



Do it  
online

Online you can make general enquiries, report crime or incidents that are **not urgent**, request a call back and leave a message for an officer. It may be quicker and easier than calling **101**.

NED

AskNED is a **Non-Emergency Directory** offering advice and information on topics that are often reported. You can also find contact details of those who can help.

It could answer your questions without you needing to call 101.

101 or 999

If you wish to speak to someone, call **101** which is our **non-emergency** number. It is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Calls are prioritised based on urgency, so there may be a delay in answering.

**Remember to call 999 in an emergency, if a crime is in progress or if someone is hurt or their life is in danger.**



If you are hard of hearing or have a speech impairment you can use the **Emergency** only SMS text service: **999**. Text 'register' to **999** or register online at [www.emergencysms.org.uk](http://www.emergencysms.org.uk)
