

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PART OF THE ESPLANADE, WEYMOUTH FOR DORSET SEAFOOD FESTIVAL 2021

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along The Esplanade from the entrance to the Pavilion Forecourt Car Park (in both directions) a distance of 100 metres. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation on Thursday 9 September and will remain in force for 18 months, however it is anticipated that the closure will be lifted on Tuesday 14 September.

This Order is required to facilitate the arrangements in connection with the Dorset Seafood Festival

There will be no signed alternative route for diverted traffic on this occasion.
