

## TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER OF VARIOUS ROADS, WEYMOUTH FOR DORSET SEAFOOD FESTIVAL 2026

DORSET COUNCIL has issued an Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to prohibit the use of the following roads by cyclists, horse riders and all mechanically propelled vehicles, except mobility scooters and powered wheelchairs in class 2 and 3, those taking part in the event and emergency vehicles, to facilitate a public event on the highway.

Between Friday 3 July 2026 and Sunday 5 July 2026, at such times as indicated by signs on site, the following temporary restrictions will apply.

[1] To impose temporary road closure on Custom House Quay between its junction with the Pavilion and its junction with St Mary Street between Friday 3 July 2026 and Sunday 5 July 2026, 9am - 9pm daily [2] To impose temporary road closure on The Esplanade on the southern section that meets Custom House Quay between Friday 3 July 2026 and Sunday 5 July 2026, 9am - 9pm daily [3] To impose temporary road closure on Devonshire Buildings for its entirety at 12pm on Friday 3 July 2026 until 9pm on Sunday 5 July 2026 [4] To impose temporary road closure on Pilgrims Way for its entirety between Friday 3 July 2026 and Sunday 5 July 2026, 9am - 9pm daily [5] To impose temporary road closure on South Parade for its entirety between Friday 3 July 2026 and Sunday 5 July 2026, 9am - 9pm daily [6] To impose temporary road closure on East Street between its junctions with Helen Lane and Custom House Quay between Friday 3 July 2026 and Sunday 5 July 2026, 9am - 9pm daily [7] To impose temporary road closure on Maiden Street between its junctions with Helen Lane and Custom House Quay between Friday 3 July 2026 and Sunday 5 July 2026, 9am - 9pm daily [8] To impose temporary clearway on Custom House Quay for its entirety at 9am on Friday 3 July 2026 until 9pm on Sunday 5 July 2026, except those associated with the event [9] To impose temporary clearway on Devonshire Buildings for its entirety at 9am on Friday 3 July 2026 until 9pm on Sunday 5 July 2026, except those associated with the event

Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by this Notice may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986. If a vehicle has been towed the owner will need to contact the towing contractor Marsh Road Garages on 01305 776116/01305 767668.
