### TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF (PART OF) THE ESPLANADE, WEYMOUTH FOR A REMEMBRANCE PARADE

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to prohibit the use of The Esplanade as described below by cyclists, horse riders and all mechanically propelled vehicles, except those taking part in the event and emergency vehicles, to facilitate this public event on the highway.

#### On Sunday 10 November 2019.

- Full closure of The Esplanade between William Street and King Street between 10:00 and midday
- Rolling road closure of The Esplanade between King Street and King Statue between midday and 12:30

The alternative route for diverted traffic will be via B3155 Dorchester Road, A354 Weymouth Way, Swannery Bridge, King Street.

#### Parking suspensions

Parking spaces will not be available at the following locations between 7:00 until approximately midday or until the above roads are open:

- The Esplanade both sides between King Street and Lennox Street
- Astrid Way
- The area fronting the Pier Bandstand
- The loading bay adjacent to Enzo's Restaurant

## Any vehicle waiting in contravention of the restrictions imposed by this Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
