TEMPORARY PHASED CLOSURES OF CUSTOM HOUSE QUAY & COMMERCIAL ROAD, WEYMOUTH

DORSET COUNCIL has made a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along CUSTOM HOUSE QUAY & COMMERCIAL ROAD, WEYMOUTH. Custom House Quay between its junctions with South Parade and St Mary Street. Commercial Road between its junctions with Lower St Alban Street and the Town Bridge. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation on 22 March 2021 between 09:00 and 16:00, Custom House Quay in place AM and Commercial Road PM, and remain in force for five days, but it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 22 March 2021.

This Notice will enable Dorset Council to carry out surfacing works.

A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed section.
