Notice to Mariners No. 20/19 (T) UPDATE**

**WEYMOUTH HARBOUR FERRY STEP AND HARBOUR WALL REPAIR**

1. This Notice to Mariners advises on the repair works that will be taking place in Weymouth Harbour at the cross-harbour Ferry Steps area in front of the Pavilion. It has been updated to reflect the extended period of the works, amendments in **bold**.
2. Engineering works will be taking place on the Ferry Steps and adjacent harbour wall metal piles either side of the Steps from Monday 30<sup>th</sup> September until ~~Christmas 2019~~ **February 2020**. The works will be shore-based but the cranes and machinery may extend up to 2.5m in to the fairway. The Ferry Steps building will be demolished. New metal piles will be driven up to 1m in front of the existing wall. A small afloat work platform may be used at times.
3. 3 unlit white buoys will be indicate the outer edge of the works area. No mooring will be permitted on the harbour wall in this area during the works. Vessels are to proceed with caution and keep wash to a minimum.
4. Cancel this Notice to Mariners on ~~Tuesday 31 December 2019~~ **Saturday 29 February 2020**.

NB. Owners, Agents, Charterers, Marinas, Yacht Clubs and Recreational Sailing Organisations should ensure that the contents of this Notice are made known to the Masters or persons in charge of their vessels or craft.
