Notice to Mariners No 3/98

OBSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC HIGHWAY

Mariners are advised that the working areas adjacent to berths No 7 to TOWN BRIDGE, inclusive, No 14 and the 'Cove Area', extend one (1) metre from the edge of the quay towards the highway. This area is controlled by the Port Authority.

The area landward of that stated in para. 1 is designated a public highway and as such is controlled by the Borough of Weymouth & Melcombe Regis (Traffic Regulation) Order 1973.

The restricted waiting yellow lines on the Harbour-side will be re-painted.

With effect from 1st July 1985 persons who obstruct the highway with keeps, pots, nets or any type of equipment will be prosecuted by the Police for contravening the Borough of Weymouth & Melcombe Regis (Traffic Regulation) Order 1973.

NB. Owners, Agents, Charterers, Marinas, Yacht Clubs and Recreational Sailing Organisations should ensure that the contents of this Notice are made known to the masters or persons in charge of their vessels or craft.
